General Comments

- I strongly encourage you to go abroad at least for one semester (in particular those who are German).
- Going abroad...
 - strengthens your language skills.
 - strengthens your intercultural skills.
 - broadens your horizon.
 - is a big plus in your CV.
 - is usually a lot of fun!
- Important: Ideally, you do not lose time when you go abroad. Your courses can be recognized in Nuremberg (please make sure that you sign a "learning agreement" before you leave).
- More information: international day (10 November)!



Applications Procedure

- We have a lot of partner universities.
 - The entire process is coordinated by the international office.
 - Thus, if you want to use this channel, please go to the international office's website and use the official form there.
 - The international office then forwards the applications to the chairs which are in charge and they select.
 - I am in charge of four programs, which I will present today.
- Obviously, you can also go to a university which does not have an agreement with us. But this usually requires more time and resources.



Options at my Chair

- Wayne State University (Detroit, Michigan)
- Université de Strasbourg (France)
- New: Charles-University Prague (Czech Republic)
- New: Paris Créteil (France)
- → The last three agreements are Erasmus agreements!



Wayne State University, Detroit

- Up to 3 students (two semesters for each student)
- Possibility to do a Master's degree in economics within 2 semesters.
- Master only takes from September to the end of April (i.e., you would only lose one semester in Germany if you accept an overlap of some weeks)



Wayne State University: Positive Aspects

- In state tuition instead of full tuition
- In the past, some students were able to cover part of it by Bafoeg or scholarships
- The deal is usually the following:
 - 8 courses (4 per semester)
 - One field of specialization (careful: rotating fields!), i.e., two PhD courses
 - Three Master's courses
 - 3 field courses
- Wayne State University has good professors, most of them have PhDs from top universities
- My guess would be that Wayne State would show up among the top 10 of the Handelsblatt ranking (if it was a German institution)
- Large German alumni group



Wayne State Univeristy: Negative Aspects

- However, Wayne State University is not a top U.S. place.
- An arbitrary ranking: 47 out of 129 economics departments (with PhD program in economics) in terms of per capita research output (Source: Southern Economic Journal, 2008).
- Detroit is a dangerous (but interesting) city!
 However, the campus is a safe place (campus police, etc.).



Wayne State University: More Information

- I did a Master's degree at Wayne State
- In addition, one of our students was there last year. Thus, I can connect you to him!



Université de Strasbourg

- Up to 6 students (for one semester)
- Three Master's degrees
- Only the Master in "Economics and Management of Innovation" is entirely in English:

• In addition, there is a Master "Macroeconomics and European Policy" and a Master "Statistics and Econometrics".



About the City of Strasbourg

- At the German-French border.
- Hosts the European Parliament and several other European institutions.
- The European Parliament comes there once a month and provides great opportunities for internships (e.g. with a member of parliament from Franconia).
- I studied in Strasbourg myself (more than 10 years ago), although not at the Université de Strasbourg. Thus, feel welcome to ask questions about the city.
